## A BILL

To amend title XI of the Social Security Act to clarify manufacturer transparency reporting requirements for certain transfers used for educational purposes.

3 **SECTION 1. CLARIFYING MANUFACTURER TRANSPARENCY**  
4 **REPORTING REQUIREMENTS FOR CERTAIN**  
5 **TRANSFERS USED FOR EDUCATIONAL PUR-**  
6 **POSES.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1128G(e)(10)(B)(iii) of  
8 the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1320a–

1 7h(e)(10)(B)(iii)) is amended by inserting “, including  
2 peer-reviewed journals, journal reprints, journal supple-  
3 ments, medical conference reports, and medical textbooks”  
4 after “patient use”.

5 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
6 this section shall apply with respect to transfers of value  
7 made on or after the date of the enactment of this Act.
