To extend temporarily the reduction of duty on certain dyed acrylic staple fibers.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN DYED ACRYLIC STAPLE FIBERS.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.40.23 of the Har-
5 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
6 certain dyed acrylic staple fibers) is amended by striking
7 “12/31/2012” and inserting “12/31/2015”.

8 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
9 subsection (a) apply with respect to goods entered, or

- 1 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
- 2 the 15th day after the date of enactment of this Act.
