3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Welfare for Terror-
5 ists Act of 2016”.

6 **SEC. 2. DISQUALIFICATION OF CERTAIN CONVICTED FEL-**
7 **ONS.**

8 Section 6(r)(1)(A) of the Food and Nutrition Act of
9 2008 (7 U.S.C. 2015(r)(1)(A)) is amended—

1 (1) in clause (iv) by striking “or” at the end,

2 (2) in clause (v) by striking “and” at the end

3 and inserting “or”, and

4 (3) by adding at the end the following:

5 “(vi) an offense under chapter 113B

6 of title 18 of the United States Code;

7 and”.
