## A BILL

To amend the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 to require issuers to disclose whether their supply chain uses the force labor Uyghurs, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Uyghur Forced Labor  
5 Disclosure Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. DISCLOSURE OF FORCED LABOR OF UYGHURS.**

7 Section 13 of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934  
8 (15 U.S.C. 78m) is amended by adding at the end the  
9 following:

1       “(t) DISCLOSURE OF FORCED LABOR OF  
2 UYGHURS.—

3               “(1) IN GENERAL.—Each issuer required to file  
4 an annual or quarterly report under subsection (a)  
5 shall disclose in that report whether the supply chain  
6 of the issuer uses the forced labor of Uyghurs.

7               “(2) TERMINATION.—The requirements under  
8 paragraph (1) shall cease to have any force or effect  
9 on the earlier of—

10                   “(A) the date that is 5 years after the date  
11 of enactment of this subsection; and

12                   “(B) the date on which the Commission—

13                               “(i) determines that such require-  
14 ments are not in the public interest or for  
15 the protection of investors; and

16                               “(ii) notifies the Congress of such de-  
17 termination, and makes such determination  
18 available to the public.”.
