## A BILL

To require the President to revoke Executive Order 13524 and restore the words removed by that Order.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “INTERPOL Immuni-  
5 ties Oversight Act of 2010”.

6 **SEC. 2. DUTY TO REVOKE EXECUTIVE ORDER 13524 AND RE-**  
7 **STORE THE WORDS REMOVED BY THAT**  
8 **ORDER.**

9 (a) IN GENERAL.—The President shall—

1           (1) revoke Executive Order 13524 (74 Fed.  
2           Reg. 67803); and

3           (2) amend Executive Order 12425 (48 Fed.  
4           Reg. 28069) so as to restore the words removed by  
5           Executive Order 13524.

6           (b) TIMING.—The President shall comply with sub-  
7           section (a) by no later than 7 days after the date of the  
8           enactment of this Act.
