A BILL

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Protecting and Secur-
5 ing Chemical Facilities from Terrorist Attacks Act of
6 2023”.

2 **CILITY ANTI-TERRORISM STANDARDS PRO-**
3 **GRAM OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND**
