A BILL

To amend the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 to ensure access of Armed Forces recruiters to secondary school campuses, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Ensuring Military Re-
5 cruitment Access Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. ARMED FORCES RECRUITER ACCESS.**

7 (a) **CAMPUS ACCESS.**—Section 8528(a)(3) of the Ele-
8 mentary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C.
9 7908(a)(3)) is amended by inserting “(including access to

1 the campus of such secondary school) for the same amount
2 of time” after “secondary school students”.

3 (b) NOTIFICATION REQUIREMENT.—Section 8528(b)
4 of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965
5 (20 U.S.C. 7908(b)) is amended to read as follows:

6 “(b) NOTIFICATION.—The Secretary, in consultation
7 with the Secretary of Defense, shall, not later than 120
8 days after the date of the enactment of this subsection
9 and annually thereafter, notify school leaders, school ad-
10 ministrators, and other educators about—

11 (1) the requirements of this section; and

12 (2) actions that may be taken to enforce the
13 requirements of this section.”.
