# H.R.4590

## AN ACT

To authorize the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to carry out certain major medical facility projects for which appropriations are being made for fiscal year 2016, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

### SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 8 (a) AUTHORIZATION.—The Secretary of Veterans Affairs may carry out the following major medical facility 9 projects, with each project to be carried out in an amount 11 not to exceed the amount specified for that project:
- 12 (1) Seismic corrections to buildings, including 13 retrofitting and replacement of high-risk buildings, 14 in San Francisco, California, in an amount not to 15 exceed \$175,880,000.
- 16 (2) Seismic corrections to facilities, including 17 facilities to support homeless veterans, at the med-18 ical center in West Los Angeles, California, in an 19 amount not to exceed \$100,250,000.
- 20 (3) Seismic corrections to the mental health and community living center in Long Beach, Cali-22 fornia, in an amount not to exceed \$282,100,000.
- 23 (4) Construction of an outpatient clinic, admin-24 istrative space, cemetery, and columbarium in Ala-25 meda, California, in an amount not to exceed 26 \$83,782,000.

2	more, California, in an amount not to exceed

5	living center in Perry Point, Maryland, in an

12	STRUCTION.—There is authorized to be appropriated to
13	the Secretary of Veterans Affairs for fiscal year 2016 or
14	the year in which funds are appropriated for the Construc-
15	tion, Major Projects, account, \$937,192,000 for the
16	projects authorized in subsection (a).
17	(c) Limitation.—The projects authorized in sub-
18	section (a) may only be carried out using—
19	(1) funds appropriated for fiscal year 2016 pur-
20	suant to the authorization of appropriations in sub-
