1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE. This Act may be cited as the "Reducing Unused 2 3 Medications Act of 2016". SEC. 2. PARTIAL FILLS OF SCHEDULE II CONTROLLED SUB-4 5 STANCES. 6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 309 of the Controlled Substances Act (21 U.S.C. 829) is amended by adding at 8 the end the following: 9 "(f) Partial Fills of Schedule II Controlled 10 Substances.— 11 "(1) Partial fills.— "(A) IN GENERAL.—A prescription for a 12 13 controlled substance in schedule II may be partially filled if— 14 "(i) it is not prohibited by State law; 15 16 "(ii) the prescription is written and filled in accordance with the Controlled 17 18 Substances Act (21 U.S.C. 801 et seq.), 19 regulations prescribed by the Attorney 20 General, and State law; 21 "(iii) the partial fill is requested by 22 the patient or the practitioner that wrote 23 the prescription; and "(iv) the total quantity dispensed in 24 25 all partial fillings does not exceed the total

quantity prescribed.
