A BILL

 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Asian Carp Action5 Plan Act of 2010".

6 SEC. 2. COORDINATION OF EFFORTS TO PREVENT THE 7 SPREAD OF ASIAN CARP.

8 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Sec-9 retary of the Army shall coordinate and lead the actions

of the Federal Government with respect to preventing the
 spread of Asian carp in the Great Lakes and the tribu taries of the Great Lakes.

4 SEC. 3. AUTHORITY TO PREVENT THE SPREAD OF ASIAN 5 CARP.

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of the Army is au7 thorized to carry out projects to prevent the spread of
8 Asian carp in the Great Lakes and the tributaries of the
9 Great Lakes, including—

- 10 (1) installing electric, acoustic, air bubble, and11 other barriers;
- 12 (2) applying piscicides;
- 13 (3) improving locks; and
- 14 (4) other projects determined necessary by the15 Secretary.

(b) APPLICATION OF OTHER LAW.—With respect to
projects carried out under subsection (a), such projects
shall be treated as in compliance with all applicable Federal laws.

20 SEC. 4. IMPLEMENTATION OF EFFICACY STUDY REC-21OMMENDATIONS.

The Secretary of the Army shall implement measures recommended in the efficacy study, or provided in interim reports, authorized under section 3061 of the Water Resources Development Act of 2007 (Public Law 110–114; 1 121 Stat. 1121), with such modifications or emergency
2 measures as the Secretary of the Army determines to be
3 appropriate, to prevent aquatic nuisance species from by4 passing the Chicago Sanitary and Ship Canal Dispersal
5 Barrier Project referred to in that section and to prevent
6 aquatic nuisance species from dispersing into the Great
7 Lakes.

8 SEC. 5. MITIGATION OF THE UPSTREAM MOVEMENT OF 9 ASIAN CARP.

10 The Secretary of the Army is authorized to take ac-11 tions at the Brandon Road Lock and Dam, Illinois, to pre-12 vent the spread of Asian carp.

13 SEC. 6. STUDY AND REPORT.

(a) STUDY.—The Secretary of the Army shall conduct a study on strategies to prevent the spread of Asian
carp with respect to the Great Lakes and the tributaries
of the Great Lakes, including—

18 (1) strategies relating to barriers for use in the19 tributaries of the Great Lakes; and

20 (2) strategies to address an arrival of Asian21 carp in the Great Lakes.

(b) REPORT.—Not later than 120 days after the date
of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of the Army shall
submit to Congress a report containing findings and legis-

1 lative recommendations resulting from the study under

2 subsection (a).
