## A BILL

To prohibit the imposition of the death penalty for any violation of Federal law, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2       This Act may be cited as the “Federal Death Penalty  
3 Prohibition Act”.

4 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON IMPOSITION OF DEATH SEN-**  
5 **TENCE.**

6       (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Notwithstanding any other provi-  
7 sion of law, no person may be sentenced to death or put  
8 to death on or after the date of enactment of this Act  
9 for any violation of Federal law.

10       (b) **PERSONS SENTENCED BEFORE DATE OF ENACT-**  
11 **MENT.**—Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any  
12 person sentenced to death before the date of enactment  
13 of this Act for any violation of Federal law shall be resen-  
14 tenced.
