## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on combination smoker, roaster, and grills.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. COMBINATION SMOKER, ROASTER, AND**  
4 **GRILLS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
6 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
7 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
8 new heading:

“	9902.01.00	Combination smoker, roaster, and grill utilizing infrared cooking technology and fueled by liquid petroleum gas (provided for in subheading 7321.11.60) .....	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2015	”.

1           (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by  
2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from  
3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after  
4 the date of the enactment of this Act.
