- 3 SECTION 1. GAO STUDY ON PROCUREMENT CONTRACTING
- 4 GOALS WITH RESPECT TO CERTAIN SMALL
- 5 BUSINESS CONCERNS.
- 6 (a) STUDY.—The Comptroller General of the United
- 7 States shall conduct a study on the performance of the
- 8 Federal Government in meeting the goals established

- 1 under section 15(g) of the Small Business Act (15 U.S.C.
- 2 644(g)) relating to participation in procurement contracts
- 3 by small business concerns owned and controlled by serv-
- 4 ice-disabled veterans and small business concerns owned
- 5 and controlled by women.
- 6 (b) Report.—Not later than 120 days after the date
- 7 of enactment of this Act, the Comptroller General shall
- 8 submit a report to Congress on the results of such study,
- 9 which shall include recommendations for improving the
- 10 performance of the Federal Government with respect to
- 11 the goals referred to in subsection (a).
