A BILL

To amend the Small Business Act to standardize reporting on procurement goals for small business concerns, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Corrective Action Re-
5 port Oversight and Accountability Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. STANDARDIZATION OF REPORTING ON PROCURE-**
7 **MENT GOALS FOR SMALL BUSINESS CON-**
8 **CERNS.**

9 Section 15(h) of the Small Business Act (15 U.S.C.
10 644(h))—

11 (1) in paragraph (1)—

12 (A) in subparagraph (A), by striking “fis-
13 cal year;” and inserting the following: “fiscal
14 year, including—

15 “(i) the percentage of the total value
16 of procurement contracts awarded to each
17 such type of small business concern de-
18 scribed in this subparagraph;

19 “(ii) the total value of procurement
20 contracts awarded to each such concern;

21 “(iii) the number of small business
22 concerns in each such type of small busi-
23 ness concern described in this subpara-
24 graph that was awarded a procurement
25 contract by the Federal agency; and

1 “(iv) the number of each such concern
2 awarded a procurement contract by the
3 Federal agency for the first time;”; and

4 (B) in subparagraph (C), by inserting “,
5 including a discussion of the actions taken to
6 implement previously proposed practices to
7 meet such goals and an analysis of the efficacy
8 of such practices” after “goals”; and

9 (2) in paragraph (2)—

10 (A) in subparagraph (D), by striking
11 “and” at the end;

12 (B) by redesignating subparagraphs (E)
13 and (F) as subparagraphs (F) and (G), respec-
14 tively; and

15 (C) by inserting after subparagraph (D)
16 the following new subparagraph:

17 “(E) a list of the best of the practices de-
18 scribed in paragraph (1)(C);”.

19 **SEC. 3. COMPLIANCE WITH CUTGO.**

20 No additional amounts are authorized to be appro-
21 priated to carry out this Act or the amendments made
22 by this Act. Such Act and amendments shall be carried
23 out using amounts otherwise appropriated to the Adminis-
24 trator of the Small Business Administration.
