To provide that the Federal Reports Elimination and Sunset Act of 1995 does not apply to certain reports required to be submitted by the Tennessee Valley Authority, and for other purposes.

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Tennessee Valley Au-
5 thority Salary Transparency Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXCEPTION TO REPORT ELIMINATION; SALARY DIS-**
2 **CLOSURE.**

3 (a) APPLICATION OF LAW.—Section 3003(a)(1) of
4 the Federal Reports Elimination and Sunset Act of 1995
5 (31 U.S.C. 1113 note) shall not apply to any report re-
6 quired to be submitted under section 9(a) of the Tennessee
7 Valley Authority Act of 1933 (16 U.S.C. 831h(a)).

8 (b) SALARY DISCLOSURE AMOUNT.—Section 9(a) of
9 the Tennessee Valley Authority Act of 1933 (16 U.S.C.
10 831h(a)) is amended by striking “\$1,500 a year” and in-
11 serting “the maximum rate of basic pay for grade GS-
12 13 of the General Schedule”.
