A BILL

To extend the temporary suspension of duty on
Chloroacetone.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CHLOROACETONE.**

4 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Heading 9902.12.05 of the Har-
5 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
6 Chloroacetone) is amended by striking the date in the ef-
7 fective period column and inserting “12/31/2015”.

8 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by
9 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or

- 1 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
- 2 the 15th day after the date of enactment of this Act.
