3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Trucking Workforce
5 Improvement Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF RULE.**

7 The final rule issued by the Federal Motor Carrier
8 Safety Administration titled “Minimum Training Require-

1 ments for Entry-Level Commercial Motor Vehicle Opera-
2 tors” issued on December 8, 2016 (81 Fed. Reg. 88732)
3 shall have no force or effect.
