 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1 SECTION 1. DEFINITION.

- 2 In this Act, the term "Arlington Ridge tract" means
- 3 the parcel of Federal land located in Arlington County,
- 4 Virginia, known as the Nevius Tract and transferred to
- 5 the Department of the Interior in 1953, that is bounded
- 6 generally by—
- 7 (1) Arlington Boulevard (United States Route
- 8 50) to the north;
- 9 (2) Jefferson Davis Highway (Virginia Route
- 10 110) to the east;
- 11 (3) Marshall Drive to the south; and
- 12 (4) North Meade Street to the west.
- 13 SEC. 2. ESTABLISHMENT OF A VISITOR SERVICES FACILITY
- 14 ON THE ARLINGTON RIDGE TRACT.
- Notwithstanding section 2863(g) of Public Law 107–
- 16 107, the Secretary of the Interior is authorized to con-
- 17 struct a structure for visitor services to include a public
- 18 restroom facility on the Arlington Ridge tract in the area
- 19 of the U.S. Marine Corps War Memorial.
