1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 2 This Act may be cited as the "Combating Terrorist
- 3 Recruitment Act of 2016".
- 4 SEC. 2. DIRECTIVE.
- 5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Homeland Secu-
- 6 rity shall incorporate, to the extent practicable, into De-
- 7 partment of Homeland Security efforts to combat terrorist
- 8 recruitment and communications the public testimonials
- 9 of former violent extremists or their associates, including
- 10 friends and family. Such efforts may include the following:
- 11 (1) Counter-messaging of foreign terrorist orga-
- 12 nization communications and narratives.
- 13 (2) Related community engagement and public
- education efforts.
- 15 (b) COORDINATION.—The Secretary of Homeland Se-
- 16 curity shall, where appropriate, coordinate the efforts de-
- 17 scribed in subsection (a) with the heads of other Federal
- 18 departments and agencies, as appropriate, and, to the ex-
- 19 tent practicable, engage nongovernmental and inter-
- 20 national partners in the identification and use of
- 21 testimonials described in such subsection.
- 22 (c) Rule of Construction.—Nothing in this Act
- 23 may be construed to require the Secretary of Homeland
- 24 Security to collect testimonials directly from former vio-

- 1 lent extremists or their associates, including friends and
- 2 family.
