1 **SECTION 1. RETROACTIVE EFFECTIVE DATE OF LAW RE-**
2 **GARDING CHARGE TO ENTITLEMENT TO DE-**
3 **PARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS EDU-**
4 **CATIONAL ASSISTANCE FOR INDIVIDUALS**
5 **WHO DO NOT TRANSFER CREDITS FROM CER-**
6 **TAIN CLOSED OR DISAPPROVED PROGRAMS**
7 **OF EDUCATION.**

8 Section 3699(c)(2) of title 38, United States Code,
9 is amended by striking subparagraph (C) and inserting
10 the following new subparagraph (C):

11 “(C) This paragraph, including clauses (ii) and (iii)
12 of subparagraph (A), shall apply with respect to the clo-
13 sure or discontinuation of a course or program of edu-
14 cation, as described in subsection (b)(1), that occurs dur-
15 ing the period beginning on August 1, 2021, and ending
16 on September 30, 2023.”.
