1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "Freedom for Health3 Care Workers Act".

4 SEC. 2. ELIMINATING THE COVID-19 VACCINE MANDATE ON 5 HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS FURNISHING 6 ITEMS AND SERVICES UNDER CERTAIN FED7 ERAL HEALTH CARE PROGRAMS.

8 The Secretary of Health and Human Services may 9 not implement, enforce, or otherwise give effect to the rule 10 entitled "Medicare and Medicaid Programs; Omnibus 11 COVID-19 Health Care Staff Vaccination" published by 12 the Department of Health and Human Services on No-13 vember 5, 2021 (86 Fed. Reg. 61555) and may not pro-14 mulgate any substantially similar rule.
