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## A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Health and Human Services to establish a grant program to encourage the development and expansion of approved medical residency training programs in rural areas.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Rural Medical Resi-  
5       dency Expansion Act of 2021”.

1     **SEC. 2. GRANT PROGRAM TO ENCOURAGE THE DEVELOP-**  
2                 **MENT AND EXPANSION OF APPROVED MED-**  
3                 **ICAL RESIDENCY TRAINING PROGRAMS IN**  
4                 **RURAL AREAS.**

5         (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Not later than 90 days after the  
6 date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Health  
7 and Human Services (in this section referred to as the  
8 “Secretary”) shall establish a program to be known as the  
9 Rural Medical Residency Expansion Grant Program (in  
10 this section referred to as the “Program”) for purposes  
11 of awarding grants during the 10-year period beginning  
12 on such date to qualifying hospitals and entities (as de-  
13 fined in subsection (d)) to facilitate the development or  
14 expansion of approved medical residency training pro-  
15 grams (as defined for purposes of section 1886(h) of the  
16 Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395ww(h))).

17         (b) **APPLICATION.**—The Secretary may award grants  
18 under the Program only to a qualifying hospital that sub-  
19 mits to the Secretary an application at such time, in such  
20 manner, and containing such information as may be speci-  
21 fied by the Secretary. Such award shall be in an amount  
22 determined appropriate by the Secretary.

23         (c) **USE OF FUNDS.**—Funds made available to a  
24 qualifying hospital pursuant to a grant awarded under the  
25 Program may only be used by such hospital to—

1                   (1) develop an approved medical residency  
2                   training program; or

3                   (2) expand an existing such program.

4                 (d) **QUALIFYING HOSPITAL AND ENTITY DE-**  
5 **FINED.**—For purposes of this section, the term “quali-  
6 fying hospital and entity” means—

7                   (1) a hospital (as defined in section 1861 of the  
8 Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395x));

9                   (2) a critical access hospital (as so defined);

10                  (3) a sole community hospital (as defined in  
11 section 1886(d)(5)(D)(iii) of such Act (42 U.S.C.  
12 1395ww(d)(5)(D)(iii)));

13                  (4) a rural emergency hospital (as defined in  
14 section 1861(kkk)(2) of such Act (42 U.S.C.  
15 1395x(kkk)(2))); or

16                  (5) an entity eligible for the Rural Residency  
17 Planning and Development Program administered  
18 by the Health Resources & Services Administration  
19 of the Department of Health and Human Services.

20                 (e) **REPORTING.**—

21                  (1) **INITIAL REPORT.**—Not later than 1 year  
22 after the date specified in subsection (a), the Sec-  
23 retary of Health and Human Services shall submit  
24 to the Committee on Energy and Commerce of the  
25 House of Representatives and the Committee on

1       Health, Education, Labor, and Pensions of the Sen-  
2       ate on how many qualifying hospitals and entities re-  
3       ceived funding under the Program and how many  
4       new residents were trained as a result of the Pro-  
5       gram.

6                 (2) SUBSEQUENT REPORTS.—The Secretary of  
7       Health and Human Services shall submit to such  
8       Committees a report that identifies the practices of  
9       residents participating in the Program (including  
10      whether such residents are practicing in a rural  
11      area) 5 and 10 years after the report is submitted  
12      pursuant to paragraph (1).

13               (f) FUNDING.—There are authorized to be appro-  
14      priated \$100,000,000 for the 10-year period beginning  
15      with the first calendar year in which the Program is estab-  
16      lished for purposes of carrying out this section.
