1 SEC. 2. COVERAGE OF CONGRESSIONAL EMPLOYEES2THROUGH EXCHANGES UNDER TITLE I OF3PPACA.

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1312(d)(3)(D)(ii)(II) of
5 the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act is amend6 ed by striking "employed by the official office of a Member
7 of Congress, whether in Washington, DC or outside of
8 Washington, DC" and inserting "of the Federal Govern9 ment whose pay is disbursed under the Legislative Branch
10 Appropriations Act for the fiscal year involved".

(b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
this section shall apply as if included in the enactment
of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act.

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
