3 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN BRAKES DESIGNED FOR BICYCLES.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.24.71 of the Har-
5 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating
6 certain brakes designed for bicycles) is amended—

7 (1) by striking ‘‘6.3%’’ and inserting ‘‘Free’’
8 and

9 (2) by striking the date in the effective peri
10 column and inserting ‘‘12/31/2015’’.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
4 the date of the enactment of this Act.
