3 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN AC ELECTRIC MOTORS OF AN OUT-**
4 **PUT EXCEEDING 74.6 W EQUIPPED WITH A CA-**
5 **PACITOR RATED NOT OVER 4 MICROFARADS.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
7 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
8 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
9 new heading:

“	9902.01.00	AC electric motors of an output exceeding 74.6 W but not exceeding 105 W, single phase; each equipped with a capacitor rated not over 4 microfarads, a rotary speed control mechanism and a motor mount cooling ring (provided for in subheading 8501.40.40)	1%	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2015	”.

1 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
4 the date of the enactment of this Act.
