## A BILL

To maintain in effect certain sanctions imposed with respect to Iraq in the event of a termination of the applicable declared national emergency, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CONTINUATION OF SANCTIONS IMPOSED.**

4 Notwithstanding any termination of the national  
5 emergency declared by the finding of the President on  
6 May 22, 2003, in Executive Order 13303 (68 Fed. Reg.  
7 31929; relating to protecting the development fund for  
8 Iraq and certain other property in which Iraq has an inter-

1 est), including a statutory termination taking effect on or  
2 after the date of this Act—

3           (1) no person included in the List of Specially  
4 Designated Nationals and Blocked Persons main-  
5 tained by the Office of Foreign Assets Control of the  
6 Department of the Treasury under the “IRAQ2” or  
7 “IRAQ3” programs may be removed from such List  
8 solely as a result of such termination; and

9           (2) no sanction imposed with respect to a per-  
10 son described in paragraph (1) may be waived solely  
11 as a result of such termination.
