A BILL

To direct the Administrator of the Environmental Protection Agency to amend regulations relating to exemptions for engines and equipment for purposes of national security, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Maintaining Our Tac-
5 tical and Operational Response Act” or the “MOTOR
6 Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENT TO REGULATIONS EXEMPTING EN-**
2 **GINES/EQUIPMENT FOR NATIONAL SECUR-**
3 **RITY.**

4 Not later than 90 days after the date of enactment
5 of this Act, the Administrator of the Environmental Pro-
6 tection Agency shall revise the regulations under section
7 1068.225 of title 40, Code of Federal Regulations (as in
8 effect on the date of enactment of this Act), to specify
9 that an engine or equipment is exempt under that section
10 without a request described in that section if the engine
11 or equipment—

- 12 (1) is for a marine vessel;
- 13 (2) has a rated horsepower of 60 or less; and
- 14 (3) will be owned by a Federal, State, or local
15 emergency response or public safety agency respon-
16 sible for domestic response or homeland security ac-
17 tivities.
