A BILL

To provide for the hiring, training, and deploying of additional Border Patrol agents along the southwest international border of the United States.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Southern Border Secu-
- 5 rity Act of 2010".
- 6 SEC. 2. INCREASE IN BORDER PATROL AGENTS ALONG
- 7 SOUTHWEST INTERNATIONAL BORDER.
- 8 The Secretary of Homeland Security shall hire, train,
- 9 and deploy additional Border Patrol agents along the

- 1 southwest international border of the United States as follows:
- 3 (1) 2,000 additional Border Patrol agents by 4 September 30, 2010, over the number of such 5 agents as of the date of the enactment of this Act.
- 6 (2) 1,500 additional Border Patrol agents by 7 September 30, 2011, over the number of such 8 agents on September 30, 2010.
