A BILL

To amend title 10, United States Code, to require preseparation counseling for members of the reserve components upon their retirement or separation from service.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Equal Access to
5 Preseparation Counseling Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PRESEPARATION COUNSELING FOR MEMBERS OF**
2 **THE RESERVE COMPONENTS.**

3 (a) REQUIREMENT; EXCEPTION.—Subsection (a)(1)
4 of section 1142 of title 10, United States Code, is amend-
5 ed—

6 (1) in the first sentence—

7 (A) by striking “Within” and inserting
8 “(A) Within”; and

9 (B) by striking “of each member” and all
10 that follows through the period at the end of
11 the sentence and inserting the following: “of—

12 “(i) each member of the armed forces whose
13 discharge or release from active duty is anticipated
14 as of a specific date; and

15 “(ii) each member of a reserve component not
16 covered by clause (i) whose discharge or release from
17 service is anticipated as of a specific date.”; and

18 (2) in the second sentence, by striking “A nota-
19 tion of the provision of such counseling” and insert-
20 ing the following:

21 “(B) A notation of the provision of preseparation
22 counseling”.

23 (b) CLARIFICATION OF COVERED MATTERS.—Sub-
24 section (b)(7) of such section is amended by striking
25 “from active duty”.
