In the Senate of the United States, December 14, 2022.

Resolved, That the bill from the House of Representatives (H.R. 5343) entitled "An Act to direct the Comptroller General of the United States to submit a report to Congress on case management personnel turnover of the Federal Emergency Management Agency, and for other purposes.", do pass with the following

AMENDMENT:

Strike out all after the enacting clause and insert:

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 2 This Act may be cited as the "FEMA Caseworker Ac-
- 3 countability Act".

4 SEC. 2. REPORT ON STAFF TURNOVER.

Not later than 180 days after the date of enactment
of this Act, the Comptroller General of the United States
shall submit to Congress a report containing—

1	(1) the turnover rate for case management per-
2	sonnel of the Federal Emergency Management Agen-
3	cy;
4	(2) the average and median length of employ-
5	ment for the personnel described in paragraph (1);
6	(3) the steps that the Agency is taking, or plans
7	to take, to lower the rate of turnover for the personnel
8	described in paragraph (1);
9	(4) the number of personnel of the Agency that
10	is detailed to work disaster recovery and then return
11	to such personnel's full time assignment after a dis-
12	aster, disaggregated by full-time, part-time, tem-
13	porary, and contract personnel; and
14	(5) the average time and median length of the
15	rotations of personnel described in paragraph (4) and
16	how often rotations and reassignment of personnel
17	occur for each disaster recovery position and function,
18	disaggregated by full-time, part-time, temporary, and
19	contract personnel.
