A BILL

To amend title 10, United States Code, to authorize the President to grant a certain retired grade to the Director of Admissions of a Service Academy.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Military Service Acad-
5 emy Director of Admissions Act of 2023”.

6 **SEC. 2. RETIRED GRADE FOR THE DIRECTOR OF ADMIS-**
7 **SIONS OF A SERVICE ACADEMY.**

8 (a) UNITED STATES MILITARY ACADEMY.—Section
9 7342 of title 10, United States Code, is amended—

1 (1) by inserting “, or the Director of Admis-
2 sions,” before “of the United States Military Acad-
3 emy”; and

4 (2) by striking “as such a professor” and in-
5 serting “in such position”.

6 (b) UNITED STATES NAVAL ACADEMY.—Section
7 8470a(a) of title 10, United States Code, is amended—

8 (1) in paragraph (2), by inserting “and subject
9 to paragraph (3),” after “subsection (b),”; and

10 (2) by adding at the end the following new
11 paragraph:

12 “(3) Upon retirement, an officer of the Navy or Ma-
13 rine Corps serving as a permanent professor, or the Direc-
14 tor of Admissions, of the United States Naval Academy
15 in the grade of captain or colonel, and whose service in
16 such position has been long and distinguished, may, in the
17 discretion of the President, be retired in the grade of rear
18 admiral (lower half) or brigadier general.”.

19 (c) UNITED STATES AIR FORCE ACADEMY.—Section
20 9342 of title 10, United States Code, is amended—

21 (1) by inserting “, or the Director of Admis-
22 sions,” before “of the United States Air Force Acad-
23 emy”; and

- 1 (2) by striking “as such a professor” and in-
- 2 serting “in such position”.
