8 (2) in subparagraph (B), by striking "that the 9 Commission determines by rule (on its own initiative or on the basis of a petition) are substantially simi-10 11 lar to the listing standards applicable to securities 12 described in subparagraph (A)" and inserting "that 13 have been approved by the Commission, consistent 14 with section 2(c) of the National Securities Ex-15 change Regulatory Parity Act of 2016";

16 (3) in subparagraph (C), by striking "or (B)";17 and

(4) by redesignating subparagraphs (B) and(C) as subparagraphs (A) and (B), respectively.

20 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by21 subsection (a) shall take effect—

(1) on the date of enactment of this Act, with
respect to a national securities exchange registered
with, and whose listing standards have been approved by, the Securities and Exchange Commission

(2) on the date the Securities and Exchange
 Commission issues the final rule required by sub section (c), with respect to a national securities ex change not described under paragraph (1).

5 (c) REPLACEMENT STANDARDS.—Not later than 360
6 days after the date of enactment of this Act, the Securities
7 and Exchange Commission shall, by rule subject to public
8 notice and comment, establish minimum core quantitative
9 listing standards pursuant to section 6 of the Securities
10 Exchange Act of 1934.
