1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. FUNDING FOR THE NATIONAL HUMAN TRAF-**
4 **FICKING HOTLINE; PERFECTING AMEND-**
5 **MENT.**

6 (a) HHS FUNDING FOR TRAFFICKING HOTLINE.—
7 Section 107(b)(1)(B)(ii) of the Trafficking Victims Pro-
8 tection Act of 2000 (22 U.S.C. 7105(b)(1)(B)(ii)) is
9 amended by striking “of amounts made available for
10 grants under paragraph (2),”.

1 (b) PERFECTING AMENDMENT.—Section 603 of the
2 Justice for Victims of Trafficking Act of 2015 (Public
3 Law 114–22; 129 Stat. 259) is amended, in the matter
4 preceding paragraph (1), by striking “Victims of Crime
5 Trafficking” and inserting “Victims of Trafficking”.

6 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
7 this Act shall take effect as if enacted as part of the Jus-
8 tice for Victims of Trafficking Act of 2015 (Public Law
9 114–22; 129 Stat. 227).
