Mr. MARSHALL introduced the following bill; which was referred to the
Committee on Natural Resources

A BILL

To authorize the Society of the First Infantry Division to make modifications to the First Division Monument located on Federal land in Presidential Park, District of Columbia, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “First Division Monu-
5 ment Modification Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. MODIFICATION OR AUGMENTATION TO FIRST DIVI-**
2 **SION MONUMENT.**

3 (a) AUTHORIZATION.—The Society of the First In-
4 fantry Division (an organization described in section
5 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 and ex-
6 empt from taxation under section 501(a) of that code),
7 may make modifications (including construction of addi-
8 tional plaques and stone plinths on which to put the
9 plaques) to the First Division Monument located on Fed-
10 eral land in Presidential Park, District of Columbia that
11 was set aside for memorial purposes of the First Infantry
12 Division. The additions will honor the members of the
13 First Infantry Division who paid the ultimate sacrifice
14 during United States operations including, but not limited
15 to, Operation Desert Storm, Operation Iraqi Freedom and
16 New Dawn, and Operation Enduring Freedom. It is esti-
17 mated that not more than 5,000 names shall be added
18 to the memorial. The First Infantry Division at the De-
19 partment of the Army shall collaborate with the Depart-
20 ment of Defense to provide the list of names to be added.

21 (b) APPLICATION OF COMMEMORATIVE WORKS
22 ACT.—Subsections (b) and (c) of section 8903 of title 40,
23 United States Code (commonly known as the “Commemo-
24 rative Works Act”), shall not apply to actions taken under
25 subsection (a) of this section.

1 (c) FUNDING.—Federal funds may not be used to pay
2 any expense of the activities authorized by this section.

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
