A BILL

To require the President to designate a legal public holiday to be known as National First Responders Day.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF NATIONAL FIRST RESPOND-**
4 **ERS DAY.**

5 Not later than 90 days after the date of the enact-
6 ment of this Act, the President shall issue a proclamation

1 that designates a date as a legal public holiday to be
2 known as “National First Responders Day”, which shall
3 be treated in the same manner as a legal public holiday
4 described in section 6103(a) of title 5, United States Code.
