3	SECTION 1. METHYLATED AND BUTYLATED MELAMINE-
4	FORMALDEHYDE POLYMER.
5	(a) In General.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
6	the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
7	amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
8	new heading:
	" 9902.01.00 Methylated and butylated melamine-formaldehyde polymer (CAS No. 68036–97–5) (provided for in subheading 3909.20.00)

- 1 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 2 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or
- 3 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after

4 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
