A BILL

To prohibit the imposition of a fine, fee, or taxation on any person for violation of a COVID–19 vaccine mandate issued by the Occupational Safety and Health Administration or any other executive agency, and for other purposes.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “No Taxation Without
3 Congressional Consent Act”.

4 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON OSHA AND OTHER EXECUTIVE**
5 **AGENCIES IMPOSING FINES, FEES, OR TAXES**
6 **WITH RESPECT TO COVID-19 VACCINE MAN-**
7 **DATES.**

8 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—No fine, fee, or taxation shall be
9 imposed on any person for violating a COVID-19 vaccine
10 mandate issued by the Occupational Safety and Health
11 Administration or any other executive agency.

12 (b) **DEFINITIONS.**—In this section:

13 (1) **COVID-19 VACCINE MANDATE.**—The term
14 “COVID-19 vaccine mandate” means any require-
15 ment that an individual receive a COVID-19 vac-
16 cine, including any requirement that an employer re-
17 quire an employee or independent contractor to re-
18 ceive such a vaccine.

19 (2) **EXECUTIVE AGENCY.**—The term “executive
20 agency” has the meaning given such term in section
21 105 of title 5, United States Code.

22 (3) **PERSON.**—The term “person” has the
23 meaning given such term in section 2510 of title 18,
24 United States Code.

25 (c) **RULE OF CONSTRUCTION.**—Nothing in this sec-
26 tion shall be construed to allow for or otherwise authorize

1 a COVID–19 vaccine mandate issued by an Act of Con-
2 gress or by an executive agency.
