## A BILL

To require a review of the completeness of the Terrorist Screening Database (TSDB) maintained by the Federal Bureau of Investigation and the derivative terrorist watchlist utilized by the Transportation Security Administration, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Fly for Foreign  
5 Fighters Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. REVIEW OF THE COMPLETENESS OF THE TER-**  
2 **RORIST SCREENING DATABASE (TSDB) MAIN-**  
3 **TAINED BY THE FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVES-**  
4 **TIGATION AND THE DERIVATIVE TERRORIST**  
5 **WATCHLIST UTILIZED BY THE TRANSPOR-**  
6 **TATION SECURITY ADMINISTRATION.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 90 days after the  
8 date of the enactment of this Act, the Attorney General,  
9 acting through the Director of the Terrorist Screening  
10 Center, shall complete a review, in coordination with ap-  
11 propriate representatives from the Department of Home-  
12 land Security and all other relevant Federal agencies, of  
13 the completeness of the Terrorist Screening Database  
14 (TSDB) and the terrorist watchlist utilized by the Admin-  
15 istrator of the Transportation Security Administration to  
16 determine if an individual who may seek to board a United  
17 States-bound flight or a domestic flight and who poses a  
18 threat to aviation or national security or a threat of ter-  
19 rorism and who is known or suspected of being a member  
20 of a foreign terrorist organization is included in such  
21 Database and on such watchlist.

22 (b) REPORT.—Not later than ten days after the com-  
23 pletion of the review under subsection (a), the Director  
24 of the Terrorist Screening Center shall submit to the Com-  
25 mittee on Homeland Security of the House of Representa-  
26 tives and the Committee on Homeland Security and Gov-

- 1 ernmental Affairs of the Senate a report on the findings
- 2 of such review.
