Mr. LEWIS introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Natural Resources

A BILL

To redesignate the Martin Luther King, Junior, National Historic Site in the State of Georgia, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Martin Luther King,
5 Jr. National Historical Park Act of 2014”.

6 **SEC. 2. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. NATIONAL HISTORICAL**
7 **PARK.**

8 The Act entitled “An Act to establish the Martin Lu-
9 ther King, Junior, National Historic Site in the State of

1 Georgia, and for other purposes.” (Public Law 96–428)
2 is amended—

3 (1) in section 1, by striking “the map entitled
4 ‘Martin Luther King, Junior, National Historic
5 Site’, numbered 489/80,013B, and dated September
6 1992” and inserting “the map entitled ‘Martin Lu-
7 ther King, Jr. National Historical Park’, numbered
8 489/80,032 and dated April 2009”;

9 (2) by striking “Martin Luther King, Junior,
10 National Historic Site” each place it appears and in-
11 sserting “Martin Luther King, Jr. National Histor-
12 ical Park”;

13 (3) by striking “national historic site” each
14 place it appears and inserting “national historical
15 park”; and

16 (4) by striking “historic site” each place it ap-
17 pears and inserting “historical park”.

18 **SEC. 3. REFERENCES.**

19 Any reference in a law (other than in this Act), map,
20 regulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
21 States to the “Martin Luther King, Junior, National His-
22 toric Site” shall be deemed to be a reference to the “Mar-
23 tin Luther King, Jr. National Historical Park”.

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
