- This Act may be cited as the "HBCU Capital Financ-

- 8 appears and inserting "bond insurance fund"; and
- 9 (2) in subsection (b)—
- (A) in paragraph (1), by striking "an" and
- inserting "a"; and
- (B) in paragraph (8), in the matter pre-
- ceding subparagraph (A), by striking "an" and
- inserting "a".
- 15 SEC. 3. STRENGTHENING TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE.
- Paragraph (9) of section 345 of the Higher Edu-
- 17 cation Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 1066d) is amended to read
- 18 as follows:
- "(9) may, directly or by grant or contract, pro-
- vide financial counseling and technical assistance to
- 21 eligible institutions to prepare the institutions to
- 22 qualify, apply for, and maintain a capital improve-
- 23 ment loan, including a loan under this part; and".
