1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

3 SECTION 1. CERTAIN WOVEN FABRICS OF SYNTHETIC FILA4 MENT YARN.

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
6 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
7 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
8 new heading:
