## A BILL

To abolish the Chemical Corps of the Army and to transfer to the Ordnance Corps of the Army the functions of and members previously assigned to the Chemical Corps.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ABOLITION OF ARMY CHEMICAL CORPS.**

4 (a) ABOLITION; TRANSFER OF FUNCTIONS.—The  
5 Chemical Corps of the Army is hereby abolished. All the  
6 functions of the Chemical Corps are hereby transferred  
7 to the Ordnance Corps of the Army. The Secretary of the  
8 Army shall reassign to the Ordnance Corps all members

1 and officers of the Army who were assigned to the Chem-  
2 ical Corps immediately before the enactment of this Act.

3 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section 3063(a) of  
4 title 10, United States Code, is amended by—

5 (1) striking paragraph (10); and

6 (2) redesignating paragraphs (11) through (13)

7 as paragraphs (10) through (12), respectively.
