4 SEC. 2. FINDINGS.

- 5 Congress finds the following:
- 6 (1) Magnetic EEG/EKG-guided resonance ther7 apy has successfully treated more than 400 veterans
 8 with post-traumatic stress disorder, traumatic brain
 9 injury, military sexual trauma, chronic pain, and
 10 opiate addiction.
 - (2) Recent clinical trials and randomized, placebo-controlled, double-blind studies have produced promising measurable outcomes in the evolution of magnetic EEG/EKG-guided resonance therapy.
 - (3) These outcomes have resulted in escalating demand from returning warriors and veterans who are seeking access to this treatment.
 - (4) Congress recognizes the importance of initiating innovative pilot programs that demonstrate the use and effectiveness of new treatment options for post-traumatic stress disorder, traumatic brain injury, military sexual trauma, chronic pain, and opiate addiction.

SEC. 3. MAGNETIC EEG/EKG-GUIDED RESONANCE THERAPY

- 2 PILOT PROGRAM.
- 3 (a) PILOT PROGRAM.—The Secretary of Veterans Af-
- 4 fairs shall carry out a pilot program to provide access to
- 5 magnetic EEG/EKG-guided resonance therapy to treat
- 6 larger populations of veterans suffering from post-trau-
- 7 matic stress disorder, traumatic brain injury, military sex-
- 8 ual trauma, chronic pain, or opiate addiction.
- 9 (b) Locations.—The Secretary shall carry out the
- 10 pilot program under subsection (a) at not more than two
- 11 facilities of the Department of Veteran Affairs.
- 12 (c) Participants.—In carrying out the pilot pro-
- 13 gram under subsection (a), the Secretary may not provide
- 14 access to magnetic EEG/EKG-guided resonance therapy
- 15 to more than 50 veterans.
- 16 (d) Duration.—The Secretary shall carry out the
- 17 pilot program under subsection (a) for a 1-year period.
- 18 (e) Report.—Not later than 90 days after the date
- 19 of the termination of the pilot program under subsection
- 20 (a), the Secretary shall submit to the Committees on Vet-
- 21 erans' Affairs of the House of Representatives and the
- 22 Senate a report on the pilot program.
- 23 (f) No Authorization of Appropriations.—No
- 24 additional funds are authorized to be appropriated to
- 25 carry out the requirements of this section. Such require-

- 1 ments shall be carried out using amounts otherwise au-
- 2 thorized.
