## A BILL

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Protecting Public Safe-  
5 ty and Federal Resources Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. DISAPPROVAL OF UNITED STATES SENTENCING**  
2 **COMMISSION AMENDMENT RELATING TO**  
3 **SENTENCES FOR DRUG OFFENSES.**

4 In accordance with section 994(p) of title 28, United  
5 States Code, the amendment numbered 3 of the Amend-  
6 ments to the Sentencing Guidelines submitted by the  
7 United States Sentencing Commission to Congress on  
8 April 30, 2014, is hereby disapproved and shall not take  
9 effect.
