## A BILL

To require a report relating to the Special Presidential Envoy  
for Climate.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SPECIAL PRESIDENTIAL ENVOY FOR CLIMATE**  
4 **REPORTING REQUIREMENTS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 90 days after the  
6 date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of State  
7 shall submit to the appropriate congressional committees  
8 a report on the following:

9 (1) Budget information detailing expenditures  
10 of the Special Presidential Envoy for Climate, dur-  
11 ing fiscal years 2021 and 2022.

1           (2) The number of temporary and full-time em-  
2           ployees currently working in the Office of the Spe-  
3           cial Presidential Envoy for Climate, including the  
4           names of all such full-time employees.

5           (3) Information on the Special Presidential  
6           Envoy for Climate’s foreign travel, including—

7                   (A) carbon emissions from air travel, as re-  
8                   quired by Executive Order 14057; and

9                   (B) the dates, attendees, and discussion  
10                  topics from all meetings with foreign leaders.

11          (b) DEFINITIONS.—In this section—

12                  (1) the term “appropriate congressional com-  
13                  mittees” means the Committee on Foreign Affairs of  
14                  the House of Representatives and the Committee on  
15                  Foreign Relations of the Senate; and

16                  (2) the term “Office of the Special Presidential  
17                  Envoy for Climate” means the staff, full-time em-  
18                  ployees, temporary employees, and contractors, sup-  
19                  porting the Special Presidential Envoy for Climate.
