A BILL

To prohibit institutions of higher education from mandating COVID–19 vaccines for students or staff.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Vaccine Mandates
5 in Higher Education Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON COVID-19 VACCINE MANDATES IN**
2 **HIGHER EDUCATION.**

3 (a) PROHIBITION.—No Federal funds may be made
4 available to any institution of higher education that re-
5 quires its students or staff to receive a COVID-19 vaccine
6 as a condition of enrollment or employment, or receiving
7 any benefit, service, or contract.

8 (b) INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION DE-
9 FINED.—In this Act, the term “institution of higher edu-
10 cation” has the meaning given the term in section 102
11 of the Higher Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 1002).
