A BILL

To require the Secretary of Energy to withdraw a proposed rule relating to energy conservation standards for consumer water heaters.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Hot Showers Act”.

5 **SEC. 2. WITHDRAWAL OF PROPOSED RULE.**

6 The Secretary of Energy—

7 (1) shall withdraw the proposed rule titled “En-
8 ergy Conservation Program: Energy Conservation

1 Standards for Consumer Water Heaters” (88 Fed.
2 Reg. 49058 (July 28, 2023)); and

3 (2) may not take any action to finalize, imple-
4 ment, or enforce the proposed rule described in
5 paragraph (1) or any substantially similar rule.
