- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. METHYL HYDROXYETHYL CELLULOSE.
- 4 (a) In General.—Heading 9902.11.86 of the Har-
- 5 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
- 6 Methyl Hydroxyethyl Cellulose with a 77% or greater con-
- 7 tent of 2-hydroxyethylmethyl ether cellulose) is amended
- 8 by striking the date in the effective period column and
- 9 inserting "12/31/2015".
- 10 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 11 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from

- 1 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
- 2 the date of the enactment of this Act.
