## A BILL

To renew the temporary suspension of duty on Methyl  
Hydroxyethyl Cellulose.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. METHYL HYDROXYETHYL CELLULOSE.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.11.86 of the Har-  
5 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to  
6 Methyl Hydroxyethyl Cellulose with a 77% or greater con-  
7 tent of 2-hydroxyethylmethyl ether cellulose) is amended  
8 by striking the date in the effective period column and  
9 inserting “12/31/2015”.

10 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
11 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from

- 1 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
- 2 the date of the enactment of this Act.
