A BILL

To amend section 151 of the Foreign Relations Authorization Act, Fiscal Years 1990 and 1991 by allowing danger pay for the U.S. Marshals Service.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Danger Pay for U.S.
5 Marshals Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENT TO SECTION 151 OF THE FOREIGN RE-**
2 **LATIONS AUTHORIZATION ACT, FISCAL**
3 **YEARS 1990 AND 1991 TO ALLOW DANGER PAY**
4 **FOR THE U.S. MARSHALS SERVICE.**

5 Section 151 of the Foreign Relations Act, Fiscal
6 Years 1990 and 1991 (5 U.S.C. 5928 note) is amended
7 by—

8 (1) striking “or” after “Drug Enforcement Ad-
9 ministration” and inserting “, the”; and

10 (2) inserting “, or the United States Marshals
11 Service” after “Federal Bureau of Investigation”.

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
